IN BRIEF

Commissioned by Queensland Gas Company (QGC) to undertake early field development works at the Berwyndale, Kenya and Codie Gasfields, located within the Surat Basin area of Queensland.

Contract works commenced in 2006 and continued until 2010 and comprised the supply and fabrication of structural steelwork, pipe spooling, supply of miscellaneous items and the installation, testing and commissioning of Field Compressor Stations (FCS) and Central Processing Plants (CPP).

Being contracted to supply and fabricate the structural steel component from our Workshop in Brisbane, delivery was fast-tracked and coordinated with the site installation schedule. This offered the client a seamless, cost effective and time efficient transition from fabrication offsite to installation on-site.
